

### INFORMATION

- Tapered adapter must be mounted in outermost holes of Center Link.
- It is NOT necessary to use the power steering version of driver-side inner tie rod with our power rack-&-pinion.
- Different tie-rod manufacturers may use longer studs that make contact with rubber boots during operation.
   These studs will have to be ground to a shorter length preventing contact and damage to protective boots.
- Locknuts can be used instead of castle nuts if stud requires shortening.
- To compensate for reproduction-tie-rod taper differences, additional flat washers have been included.
   Place washers underneath the castle nut or locknut to remove free play if needed.
- Torque nuts to 35-45 lb. ft.
- Bend prongs of cotter pins in opposite directions until they are somewhat flat against nut to prevent pin from rotating and damaging protective boots.
